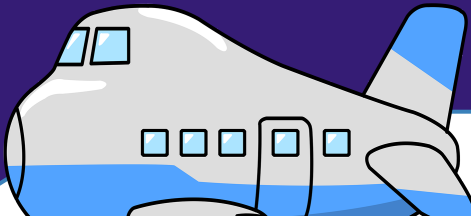

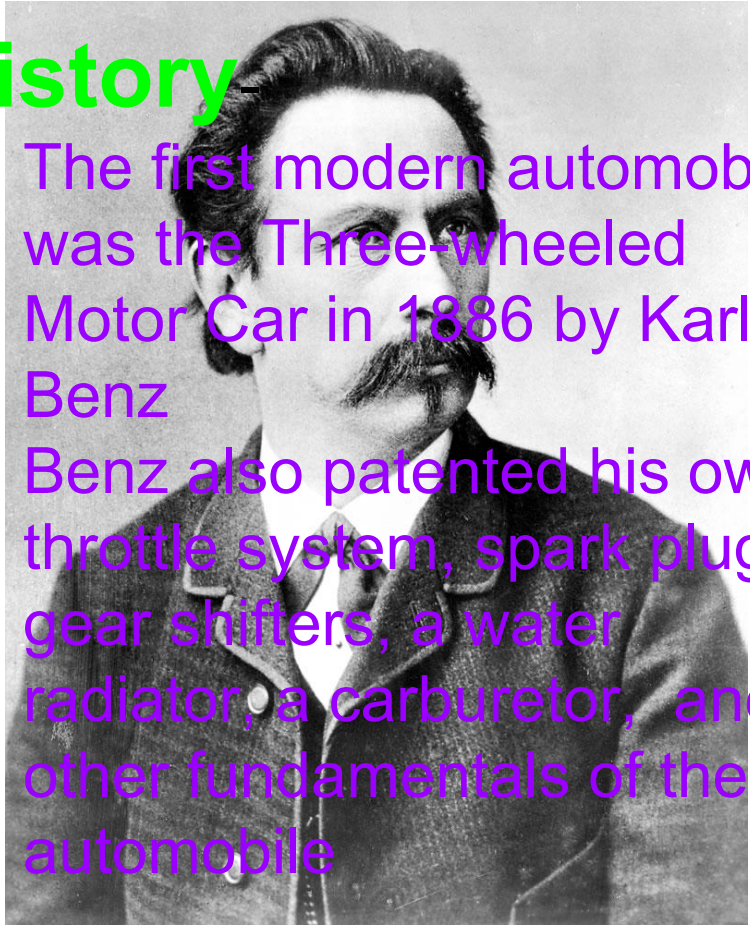

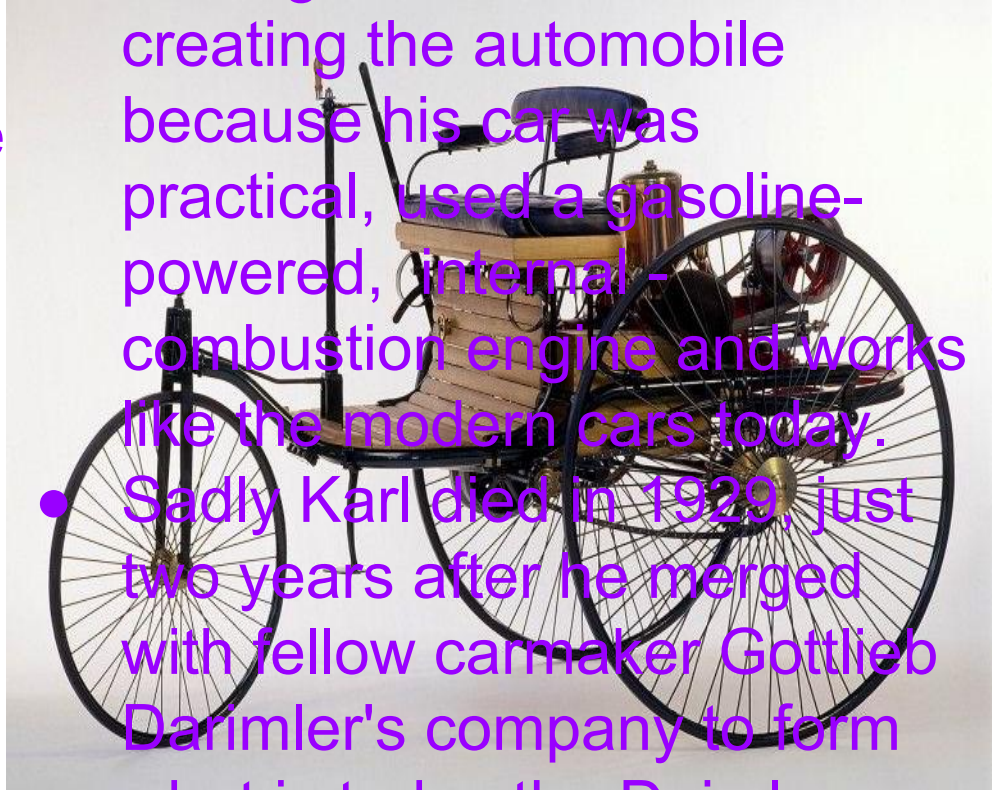
# THE AUTOMOBILES: 🚗

## History

- The first modern automobile was the Three-wheeled Motor Car in 1886 by Karl Benz
- Benz also patented his own throttle system, spark plugs, gear shifters, a water radiator, a carburetor, and other fundamentals of the automobile



- Benz gets the credit for creating the automobile because his car was practical, used a gasoline-powered, internal-combustion engine and works like the modern cars today.
- Sadly Karl died in 1929, just two years after he merged with fellow carmaker Gottlieb Daimler's company to form what is today the Daimler Group

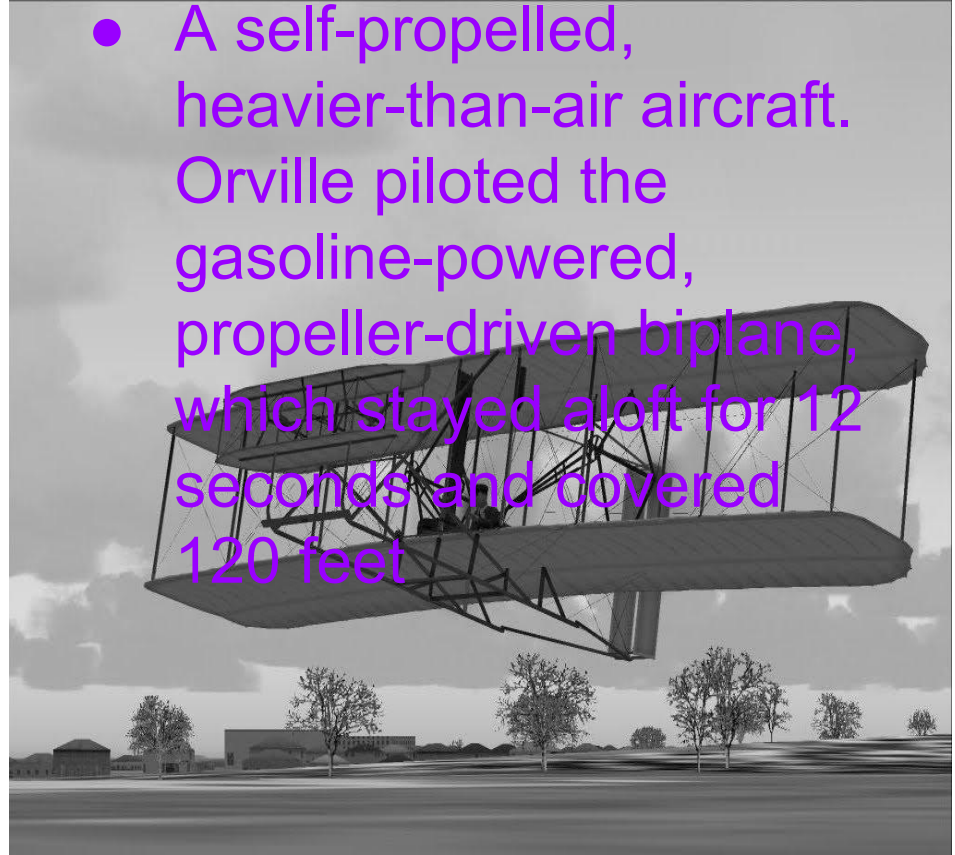
# THE AIRPLANES : ✈️

## History

- On December 17, 1903, Wilbur and Orville Wright made four brief flights at Kitty Hawk with their first powered aircraft. The Wright brothers had invented the first successful airplane



- A self-propelled, heavier-than-air aircraft. Orville piloted the gasoline-powered, propeller-driven biplane, which stayed aloft for 12 seconds and covered 120 feet

- Born in Beaver, Utah, on August 19, 1906, Philo T. Farnsworth was a talented scientist from a young age, having begun inventing in grade school



